Section I.

The Village Board of the Village of Rushville, Ontario and Yates Counties, New York, has determined that it is in the best interest of the public and for the safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the Village of Rushville to regulate and control the parking of vehicles within the Village of Rushville.

Section II.

The provisions of this article are enacted pursuant to the authority vested in the Village Board of the Village of Rushville in accordance with the provisions of the Vehicle and Traffic Law of the State of New York.

Section III.

The provisions of this article shall apply to all those streets or portions thereof lying and being in the Village of Rushville. The provisions of this article shall apply except when it is necessary to stop vehicles to avoid conflict with other traffic or in compliance with the directions of a police officer, other law enforcement officer or official traffic control device.

A local law to regulate and control the parking of motor vehicle within the streets of the Village of Rushville.

As section III requires the following list of streets will have No Parking Anytime.

Bassett Street

Bryant Square

Castle Street

Chapel Street

Green Street

Hill Street

Pine Street

Railroad Avenue

Rubin Drive

South Main Street (County Road # 1)

Union Street

Warehouse Street

Warren Street

Water Street

Section III

The parking of vehicles at ant time is hereby prohibited on either side of the following streets in the Village of Rushville: see attachment.

Section IV.

The parking of vehicles is hereby prohibited on any street in the Village of Rushville: No parking anytime

Section V.

The parking or standing of vehicles is hereby prohibited at all times in: a) any area designated as a handicapped parking zone, either on public or private property without proper authorization and; b) any area designated as a fire lane, either on public or private property.

Section VI.

In the event that a vehicle parked in violation of this Article is removed, the owner or other person lawfully entitled to possession of such vehicle may be charged with the reasonable cost for the removal and storage, which amounts must be paid prior to the release of such vehicle.

Section VII.

The provisions of this Article shall not be construed to prohibit the delivery or pickup of merchandise or other property or the operation of motor vehicle of any municipal or school district upon the streets of the Village of Rushville.

Section VIII.

The Village of Rushville and its duly authorized agents shall obtain and install signs along all streets within the Village of Rushville affected by this Article indicating the appropriate parking regulations. No person shall interfere with or remove any sign placed within the Village of Rushville, except with the approval and consent of the Village Board.

Section IX.

Every person found to be in violation of this Article shall be guilty of a traffic infraction and shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$250 and/or imprisonment for a period of not more than 15 days. All fines imposed pursuant to the provisions hereof shall be automatically be doubled if such fines are not paid within 10 days of issuance of the citation for such violation.

Section X.

This Article shall take effect upon its adoption by the Village Board, the filings thereof with the Secretary of State and the installation of the signs referred to in Section VIII.
